## SCHAUNANAN'S - HALL OF FAME

## DUNKER WINS HIS 29th

Madison Pheasant League hosted the 1981 South Dakota State Horseshoe Tournament over the traditional Labor Day weekend. Playing was the largest field yet entered in the State Tournament.

Farther along in the pages you will find the individual results, class by class with the winner listed the first in each class and so on down the list, place by place. In capital letters is the players overall record, then follows the game by game record, showing a win or loss, total points, ringers, total of shoes pitched and ringer percent. The high ringer percent for a game in each class is indicated by the word 'high' next to that percentage.

Rain again marred the play and this was especially regrettable as there were those from a distance who could not stay around or come back to compete. The four top men's classes played 50 point games, the other men's classes were 30 point games. All the ladies played 50 shoe games. Next year all the tournament classes will play 50 shoe games, as determined at the annual business meeting. The hosting club wishes to

Inducted to South Dakota Horseshoe Hall of Fame for 1981 was the personable duo of Don and Hazel Schaunanan of Aberdeen. Research by the secretary noted that this will be the 50th South Dakota State tournament. Play at State level began in 1924, but there were years when there was no tournament so next year will be the fiftieth.

At the Saturday evening banquet and business meeting the couple were presented a trophy and their names were added to the Hall of Fame plaque, which was given last year to the South Dakota Horseshoe Pitchers by the family of George Paulsen. This plaque shows all the inductees to the Hall of Fame.

DIRECTORS MEETING - A majority of the State Directors and the 1981 Officers met Saturday afternoon at Madison Elks Club. Director Myrlene Schliemann could not be present so Marie Hallickson sat in on the meeting in her stead. Discussion held on tournament entry averages. Motion made that go back twelve months including the previous state tournament. This had been 15 months. The motion made by Roland Jensen and seconded by Monte Herreman. Motion carried. It was suggested there be four blank spaces put on entry form for the four high tournament or league play percentages to average.

Don Schaunaman moved there be 50 shoe play in all divisions. After much discussion relative to top four divisions, and possibility of host town deciding points or shoes, and putting on tourney notice a place to indicate whether entrant would favor 50 shoes or 50 points, seconded with modifications by Al Neuharth. More discussion and no vote, second withdrawn, motion withdrawn. Forest Gaetze then moved that there be 50 shoes in all divisions in State tournament, seconded by Marie Hallickson. Motion carried on 11 to 3 vote. Harry Everhart moved there be no handicap play in any division. Seconded by Franklin Tomsik and carried. (continued)

Roland Jensen moved that SDHPA provide \$100.00 for attendance and participation in World Tournament as player entrant and attend convention as a delegate with this divided \$50.00 for men's State Champion and \$50.00 for ladie's State Champion and in the event they cannot or will not attend, this to be offered to the runner up in each case, then to Regional Director, Assistant, then President, Vice-President, then Secretary-Treasurer, in that order. Seconded by Tomsik and carried.

Kalvig brought up the suggestion made last year that there be one-third of directors be elected, with those drawing the one year to go term last year to propose a replacement and nominated Gene Austad of Ojdham as his replacement. Don Schaunaman nominated by Tomsik. There being no other nominations matter dropped to be brought up at general business meeting.

Brown County Horseshoe Association of Aberdeen offered to host tournament for 1982 if no new town made an offer. No other offers noted and group endorsed the bid.

President to select four directors to pick the Hall of Fame inductee. Bill Alfson announced the committee to be Loren Olesen of Arlington, Myrline Schliemann of Sioux Falls, Cliff Sorenson of Brookings and Monte Herreman of Rapid City.

The directors meeting adjourned. Secretary.

GENERAL BUSINESS MEETING - at banquet Saturday evening at Madison Elks Club. Minutes of previous meeting read and approved. Commissioner Neuberger presided at this meeting, and made introductions. Madison Mayer Wilmer Mette welcomed the group.

Minutes and recommendations of Board of Directors introduced - tournament entry ringer percentage to be from last 12 months, including previous State tournament average as the starter with average of four highest percentages during the year - all games in State tournament to be 50 shoe games - there to be no handicaps in State tournament play - \$50.00 to the champs and succession as outlined in directors meeting - Aberdeen to host the 1982 tournament and officers to be named by Aberdeen club - Donald Coy of Parker moved the package be adopted, seconded by James Bauer of Rapid City and carried.

For directors Kalvig nominated Gene Austad, Gene Ebbreshman nominated Don Schaunaman, Don Schaunaman nominated Cliff Swayze, Neuberger nominated Forest Gaetze and Willard Waddle nominated Gay Johnson. No other nomination, these declared elected.

Hall of Fame for 1981 announced - Don and Hazel Schaunaman, Aberdeen. Remarks made as from the news story in this paper and the honorees made response.

General business meeting adjourned. Secretary

MARLOW NEUBERGER - S. DAK. HORSESHOE COMMISSIONER - MY REPORT FOR 1981

I want to thank the directors for their service. Without these people we could not have horseshoe tournament. Just think - 160 people played in the State this year.

Again I want to stress the importance of playing in your right division. Out of 160 people we had a few people, probably three to be more exact, who were out of class. If people insist a winning a trophy, to put it plainly "sand bagging" just to win, well I don't think we need these people in our state tournament. In the future these people will be closely watched and may lose their chance to play in the State Tournament. If the shoe fits, take due notice and govern yourself accordingly.

For 1982 the directors and the assemblage decided that we would only go back one year for ringer percentage. This should make it easier for you to keep track of your averages. Remember your four highest tournaments from Sept. 1, 1981 to Sept. 1, 1982. If you have only 3 average that, if you have only 2 average that, and if you have only 1 use that. League average also can be used, it must always be highest average. 1981 State tourney average is the beginning.

The Madison Pheasant League did a tremendous job putting on the State Tournament, with the rain and all.

It is a lot of long hard work, from all of us who just play and do no work it doesn't hurt to say "Thank You" to those who labored so we could play. I have the 1982 NHFA National Cards. Get them early. Anyone who carries a NHFA card and win their class in any tournament may get a patch showing class champion, MUST hold a card. Listed elsewhere in the report are those who paid their state dues twice and thus have credit for State Dues for 82.

Notes and editorial comment continued-

Immediately after the tournament there was talk again about the method of determining winners in cases of ties by won-loss record. There was some correspondence on this and those that did write seemed to favor ringer percentage method. However this must be done at the annual meeting if there is to be a change. So this should be taken up at the next directors meeting and at the general meeting, and for 1982 will be points as before.

As in all sports, winning is the name of the game in horseshoe, also, and so there has to be a method of determination. Could be play-off, points or ringer percent. Advocates of the ringer percent say, 'ringers is the name of the game' and I guess it is, you get three points for a ringer. That should help in adding up points for total points determination. There is an older saying, 'close only counts in horseshoe' and let's let close still count. For a moment let us look at some other sports. In basketball there are three-point field goals, two point field goals and free throws. We see many games won by free throws. In baseball we might say 'home runs is the name of the game' and they play a big part, but a single, a stolen base, a bunt or a sacrifice may be the winning margin. In football, we could say, 'touchdowns are the name of the game' but there are other ways of scoring - point after, two points for running in the ball after, safeties, and field goals. Field goals win many football games.

Let's let close still count in horseshoe. In our league we handicap according to ringer ability, and keep compiling and changing the handicaps as the season progresses. We then try to pair competitors by handicap. A few years ago, our team had a member that got very few ringers, but you had better have one, or he was likely to score on you.

Another thing, to my way of thinking, as I look over the records, is the happening during tournaments of a person getting an extremely hot game or an extremely cold game for his ability and thus distorting the overall percent in the tourney for him. We had an example of a very high game by a player who won his class 6-1. He was tied in wins and losses with player number two, and won by 259 to 250 points, quite close, yet his ringer percent was far more average by virtue of this one hot game.

I like the points, and have spoke my piece here, but will certainly go along with the majority without a quibble. I did check through this years tourney, figuring W/L ties by both ways, and overall results would be very close one way or the other.

It has been a pleasure to be on the board for a number of years, and to be the secretary again this year. My best to horseshoe and all you fine players.
