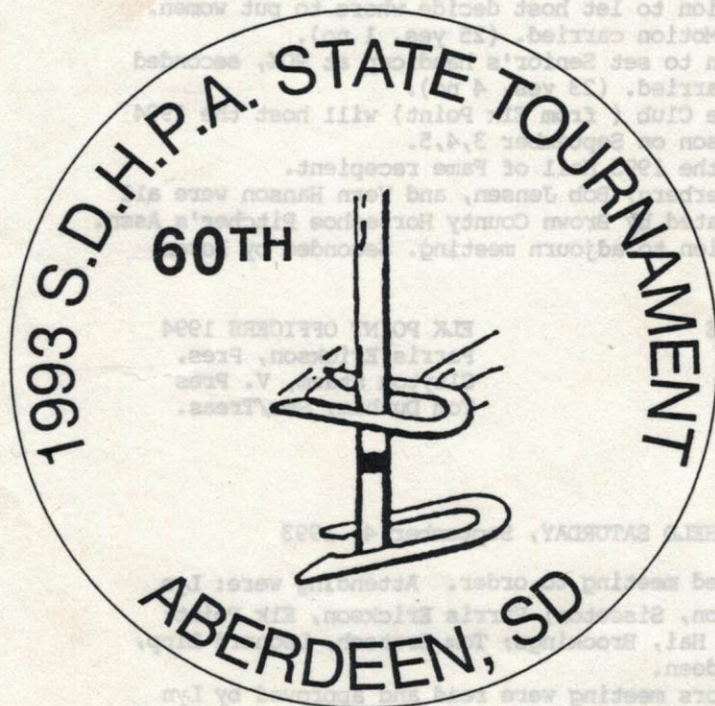


# 1993 60th South Dakota State Horseshoe Tournament

GENERAL MEETING 1993

The meeting was called to order by President Tom Bretsch. Lyn Hanson made a motion the 1992 minutes not be read because they were printed in the 1992 State booklet. Motion seconded by Carvel Hauge. Passed. Treasurer's report was read by Val Schnoor and approved. 1993 Directors minutes were read by Val. Schnoor.

Douglas Hai made a motion to accept David Zilverberg's motion for 70 year and older to pitch in all respective classes according to ringer percent, from not less than 30 feet. Lyn Hanson seconded. Discussion was made.

David Zilverberg made a motion to raise age from 65 to 70 for Seniors to throw at no less than 30 feet. Byron Edwards seconded. Motion carried. (Ballot vote 27 yes., 5 no)

David Zilverberg made a motion to allow 70 year and older to pitch in respective classes according to ringer percent (including Championship) in SDSHPA tournament at no less than 30 feet. Motion defeated. (Ballot 16 yes, 18 no).

Dennis Kjose made motion to handicap Seniors class in SDSHPA tournament. Seconded by Loren Oleson. Motion carried.

LaMoyne Helgeson made a motion that 4 or less women entered in SDSHPA tournament be allowed to pitch in respective Classes (including Champion) according to ringer percent from not less than 30 feet. Seconded by Curt Bain. Motion defeated. ( 7 yes, 13 no).

Laverne Wipf made a motion that everybody be nationally sanctioned, seconded by Robert Jensen. Motion defeated. ( 8 yes, 19 no).

Loren Oleson made motion to let host decide where to put women. Seconded by Laverne Wipf. Motion carried. (25 yes, 1 no).

Donna Roth made motion to set Senior's handicap at 90%, seconded by Ted Chambers. Motion carried. (23 yes, 4 no).

Sioux Valley Horseshoe Club ( from Elk Point) will host the 1994 SDSHPA Tournament, in Madison on September 3,4,5.

LaVerne Fickbohm was the 1993 Hall of Fame receipient.

Marie Lipp, Dave Zilverberg, Bob Jensen, and Vern Hanson were all winners of door prizes donated by Brown County Horseshoe Pitcher's Assn.

WARNER — Leigh J.H. Dunker, 78, rural Warner, died Saturday, Nov. 20, 1993, at his home.

Leigh John Henry Dunker was born March 23, 1915, to John and Marie (Volk) Dunker on the family farm two miles south of Warner. He attended Wright rural school and Warner School. After he finished school, he farmed with his parents and later, he and his sister Eleonora continued to operate the farm. He lived all his life on the farm on which he was born.

He was one of South Dakota's outstanding sportsmen. He played amateur baseball for Stratford, Warner and Mansfield. He was an active bowler for many years, bowling in several leagues. His greatest sports achievements were in pitching horseshoes. He won his first state championship in 1934, when he was 19 years old. From 1934 to 1989, he won the state title 35 times. In 1974, he was the subject of an article in Sports Illustrated and received the Sports Illustrated Award of Merit. He was named South Dakota Independent Athlete of the Year by the South Dakota Sports Writers Association in 1975 and the Aberdeen American News Athlete of the Week in 1988. In 1991, he was inducted into the South Dakota Hall of Fame in recognition of his achievements.

He was a member of St. John's Lutheran Church in Warner, the Moose Lodge in Aberdeen and was a past secretary of the South Dakota State Horseshoe Pitchers As-

sociation.

Survivors include one sister, Eleonora Dunker of Warner.

He was preceded in death by his parents.

Honorary casketbearers will be the members of the Horseshoe Association and the members of his bowling leagues.

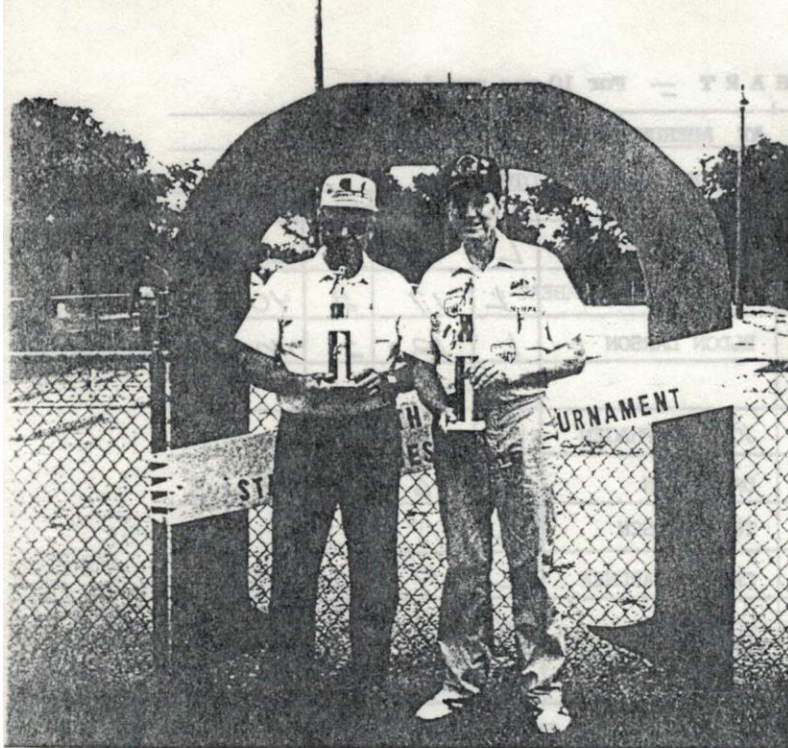
