

Officers Meeting

Moose Lodge Ft Pierre 8/31/2001 7:00PM

Kent Robinson called the meeting to order. Kurt Whaley read the minutes from the winter officers' meeting held in Sioux Falls. The minutes were approved as read. The treasurer's report was presented to the group.

The group discussed whether holding the singles on Saturday was acceptable, or if going back to Sunday was preferable. No decision was made.

Clint Bryson reported that everything was in place for the Hall of Fame. He noted that the traveling plaque is nearly full, and another will need to be purchased soon.

Kurt reported that the trophy cost was higher than the previous year. Several trophy shops have indicated that they do not wish to bid on the trophies, since the cost has been driven down to the point that there is no profit remaining. The idea of presenting plaques instead of trophies for the doubles' tournament was discussed as a possible way to save money. Clint indicated that he might be able to make the plaques, but would have to have them engraved elsewhere.

Roland Kleinschmidt raised the discussion about how a 4-way tie should be settled in tournament class. It was determined that the format of such play-offs would at the tournament director's discretion. The group discussed creating a set of guidelines for tournament directors to use when holding tournaments. These would not be mandated, but just recommendations.

The group believed that each sanctioned tournament should pay the state \$6.00 for the sanction. In the past it was normally only collected for tournaments that were advertised on the preseason schedule.

NHPA rule changes were discussed. The three-points rule, states that a shoe is a ringer, even if a straight edge being used to measure the shoe, touches both points of the shoe as well as the stake. This was defeated. The NHPA did adopt a 23-foot pitching distance for young pitchers. Juniors can pitch from this distance until they are nine years old.

The tournament was discussed, to make sure everything was ready. Assignments were made for checking in players, weighing shoes, and collecting scorekeepers fees in advance. The 50-50 drawing was discussed.

Clint will do the 2002 schedule again. Schedule should include tournament time. Kurt stated that people try to enter tournaments after the deadline. This causes problems when time of play is being to sent to pitchers.

Kent stated that Bell Fourche would like to host either the 2002 or 2003 state tournament. They submitted a bid to the secretary, before the July 1 deadline. Pierre has offered a standing invitation to the state organization to host the tournament each year.

Roland Kleinschmidt was the only nomination for the office of President. No nominations were received for the office of 2nd Vice President.

The meeting was adjourned.

Business Meeting

Moose Lodge Ft Pierre 9/01/2001 8:00PM

Kent Robinson called the meeting to order. Kent asked if the group wanted the minutes read from the previous year. Roland Kleinschmidt moved that we suspend from the reading of the previous minutes. Butch Finton seconded the motion.

Kent presented the treasurer's report. Butch Finton moved to approve the report. Clair Harris seconded the motion.

The World tournament at Hibbing MN was discussed. South Dakota had 24 pitchers attend the event. Those pitchers who were present were recognized. Butch Finton and Kent Robinson were the South Dakota delegates at the NHPA business meeting. Some of the issues that were discussed at the NHPA meeting included:

- 1. Court dimensions
- 2. Thirty foot stake (having it drawn as if it was there)
- 3. Definition of elders (did not change)
- 4. Three point touch rule (did not change)
- 5. Junior pitching distance of 23 feet (ages 9 and under)

The 2002 world tournament will be held in Red Deer, Alberta. The 2003 world tournament will be in Eau Claire Wisconsin.

Sanctioned local tournaments were discussed. Some clubs are not sending the \$6.00 to the state secretary. All sanctioned tournaments need to send this fee to the state. It was decided that a packet should be sent to tournament directors, with recommendations for such things as tie-breakers. Was noted that people are getting slack about getting their entries to tournament directors in a timely manner.

There was some discussion regarding the singles tournament being held on Saturday, and the doubles on Sunday.

The office of President was up for election. Kent Robinson the current president did not run for reelection. Roland Kleinschmidt was the only name submitted for the office of President. Bob Schnaible moved to approve the nomination. Clair Harris seconded. The vote carried. No names were submitted for the office of 2nd Vice President. An appointment will be made for this office.

The Pierre Club extended a written invitation to the non-sanctioned group to hold their tournament in Pierre for 2002, in conjunction with the sanctioned group.

Belle Fourche indicated that they would like to host the 2002 state tournament. After some discussion it was decided that based on SDHPA policy, they would need to bid for the 2003 tournament. A vote was held to determine if the 2003 tournament would be held in Pierre or Belle Fourche. Belle Fourche was selected as the 2003 state tournament site.

Clint Bryson presented the 2001 Hall of Fame to Lovell and Phyllis Wheeler, and Clair Harris.

The meeting was adjourned.
