Since the state tournament, directors from the sanctioned organization met with some from the non-sanctioned group, to determine what can be done to get the two groups together. This meeting was held in Pierre on Oct 13<sup>th</sup>. The meeting went well. The consensus of most present, is that we should move slowly, and that the first good step, is for both groups to pitch together in Sioux Falls at the 2004 State tournament. Most agreed that the long term goal, is to have one organization in the state, but no one is sure how to get there yet. The sanctioned group offered to give the non-sanctioned group the day of their choice for pitching singles. They chose Saturday, for various reasons, so the sanctioned singles would be played on Sunday, in Sioux Falls 2004. The doubles play if held, would be on Monday.

Another winter indoor tournament has been scheduled at Hankinson ND. This is at the Dakota Magic casino. The dates will be January 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> 2003. The casino will add \$1000.00 in prize money again this year. Although it is located in North Dakota, it is sponsored by SDHPA, and the location is right on the border. It is Exit 1 in North Dakota when traveling north on I-29. Hope to see more South Dakota pitchers participate. We can only accommodate 48 pitchers on Saturday, and 32 on Sunday. I will be sending out entry forms within the next month.



#### Carl Chambers



He devoted the summer of 1998 to working on them; even giving up fishing. They formed their own horseshoe club and league play. All the hard work really paid off, when they got to host tournaments and even the State Tournament. His wife, Judy, travels with him and has acquired quite an interest in the sport by learning to keep score, practicing on the sheets

Royal Adamson sent her, while Carl pitched in the backyard. The couple has met many nice people and looks forward to seeing them at tournaments. Someday, he hopes to pitch in the World Tournament. He is a willing worker, and is always one of the first ones there and the last to leave when it's time to prepare the courts for a tournament or league play and has been tournament director several times. Officers Meeting

Moose Lodge Ft Pierre 8/30/2002 7:00 PM

Roland Kleinschmidt called the meeting to order.

First topic of discussion, were the tournament director guidelines that were written this year. The group would like all tournament directors to adhere to these guidelines. Minimal modifications were made to them. It was also brought up, that tournament directors must have a subscription to the NHPA Newsline magazine. This is a result of a change in the NHPA bylaws. Clubs may want to purchase the Newsline subscription for a local tournament director, who does not have a subscription. A one year subscription is \$12.00, two years \$22.00 and three years \$30.00. It is a very informative magazine for those who enjoy pitching horseshoes.

The office of Secretary-Treasurer was up for reelection, but no one submitted a nomination. Kurt Whaley was not interested in holding this office for another term. Roland will make an appointment to fill the office. Kurt indicated that he would be interested in doing some publicity for the organization. Roland appointed Kurt to Publicity/Promotions Director. He would be responsible for sending several newsletters to the members each year.

Discussion arose regarding whether singles should be played on Saturday or Sunday for future state tournaments. A proposal was presented, which would allow the host club to choose which day the singles would be played, and which day the doubles would be played.

The group talked about the possibility of holding the State Tournament in Sioux Falls in 2004. Warren Clark of the non-sanctioned group, had talked to Roland, and Kurt previously about this arrangement. There was interest in the idea, and Butch Finton indicated that he would submit Sioux Falls as a possible candidate location at the Saturday banquet.

Butch Finton had submitted a change to the state constitution, and a change to the policies. The change to the constitution, was to Article IV, Section 7, which states that all state tournament games shall be 50 shoes. Since the body was not notified that the rule was up for change, in a summer newsletter, it could not be voted on. It will be voted on at the 2003 business meeting. The policy that was suggested to change, was "the \$12.50 state tournament entry fee". The group decided that this should be brought before the body at the business meeting.

There was a lot of discussion about trophies vs. prize money for the state tournament. Some people like the trophies, while others would prefer the money. One idea was to only have a first place trophy in each class, and then pay cash for each placing. Jeff Putzier, stated that each club should be challenged to raise money, so that cash could be paid, even if trophies were given. The Sioux Falls club raised \$200.00 at the Hankinson tournament, and plans to raise as much, or more this year. Their goal is to give the money to the state tournament, cash prize fund. The group discussed having some T-shirts with the state logo printed on them, to raise some money.

Everyone took assignments for helping with the tournament on Saturday and Sunday.

The meeting was adjourned.

**Business Meeting** 

Moose Lodge Ft Pierre 8/31/2002 8:00 PM

Roland Kleinschmidt called the meeting to order.

A motion was made to suspend reading of last years meeting minutes. The treasurer's report was submitted. Clair Harris moved to approve the report as read. Second by Harlan Nielsen. The report was approved.

The first order of discussion was the office of Secretary-Treasurer. No nominations were submitted for the office before the July 1st deadline. Kurt Whaley indicated that he was not interested in holding the office for another term. Ruben Martinez showed interest, but is sometimes away from the state for extended periods. He will reevaluate in one year. The president will appoint a Secretary-Treasurer. The current officers all stood, and were recognized.

The newly written tournament director's guidelines were read to the body. They will be adopted by the organization and will become part of the State Policies. All tournament directors should try to adhere to these guidelines. The guidelines will be shared with all, in the near future. Also regarding tournaments, it is now mandatory, per NHPA bylaws, that all tournament directors have a current subscription to the NHPA Newsline. We should be in pretty good shape, since state officers have always been required to have this subscription. If a tournament director does not have a current subscription, the local club may want to purchase one for the director.

Butch Finton had submitted a change to the state constitution, and a change to the policies. The change to the constitution, was to Article IV, Section 7, which states that all state tournament games shall be 50 shoes. Since the body was not notified that the rule was up for change, in a summer newsletter, it could not be voted on. It will be voted on at the 2003 business meeting. The policy that was suggested to change, was "the \$12.50 state tournament entry fee". Clint Bryson made a motion to raise the state tournament entry fee to \$15.00. William Kester seconded. The vote carried. A Policy will be added to the State Policies stating, "The State Tournament entry fee shall be \$15.00"

This lead into a lengthy discussion regarding trophies vs. cash for state tournament awards. Several idea were presented, but in the end, it was decided by vote, that we would continue giving trophies. If money can be raised, or sponsors found, then any of that money could go to awarding cash prizes in addition to trophies. Jeff Putzier said that local clubs should be challenged to raise money. The Sioux Falls club indicated that they would continue adding money to the State Tournament prize fund, from the Dakota Magic Casino tournament. More to come on this topic next season.

Butch Finton invited the organization to hold the 2004 state tournament in Sioux Falls. The non-sanctioned group has indicated that they would like to play in the same location in 2004, and their intention is to play in Sioux Falls. Carl Chambers reminded the body that Pierre has a standing invitation to hold the tournament each year. After much discussion, and a very close vote, Sioux Falls was awarded the 2004 tournament.

Discussion was had about having the State Singles on Saturday vs. Sunday. It was decided that it would be a good idea to let the host club decide. This will be written into the State Policies.

The world tournament contestants were recognized. Monte Herreman was recognized for thirty years consecutive NHPA membership. Also noted that Kurt received the NHPA Presidents award for 2002 for computer software written for their use. Door prized donated by local merchants, and Pierre club members, were given to many of those present.

Clair Harris presented the 2002 SDHPA Hall of Fame to Carl Chambers and Kent Robinson. These are two very deserving inductees. We welcome them to the Hall of Fame

The meeting was adjourned.
