## 2012 South Dakota Horseshoe Hall-Of-Fame



*Ron Schoon & Family*

Ronald Schoon, better known as Ron is married to Betty for 44 years and counting. They have 4 children (2 girls and 2 boys) and 7 grandchildren. He is a member of Trinity Lutheran Church where he has served as Church Elder for many years. He worked for Spencer Grain in Spencer, SD for 35 years until the Spencer tornado. He has been a volunteer fireman for many years. He has been the Spencer Zoning Administrator for 14 years.

Ron has been a member of SDHPA for 15 years. He has actively participated in tournaments in Sioux Falls and Pierre and has pitched in the state tournament many years. In the past couple of years Ron has had health issues and pitching from 40 feet was painful for him. He refused to get a doctor's note to pitch at 30 feet and wanted to wait until he turned 70 years of age. He also did not want to give up pitching horseshoes until that time so pitched anyway in pain. You would not know he was in pain because he did not complain and pitched because of his love for the game and the people.

This past year Ron found out he had a heart condition and colon cancer. He bought his horseshoe card anyway just in case he felt up to pitching this year but the doctors told him to take a year off. He still came to the Sioux Falls tournament in June and was there to cheer on everyone who was pitching. His love for the game and his horseshoe family is evident. His face brightens up when he talks about the game.

Carlene Barber's fondest memory is watching Ron and Gene Ewing throw against each other. When done throwing they sometimes just sit on the backboard and talk a bit before continuing on with the game. When I personally started pitching I pitched against Ron. I was terrified. Ron was there showing me that there was nothing to fear but a lot to gain with being a member of the horseshoe family. He taught me not to give up on a ringer and to dig in the clay to make sure that it was or not a ringer. I watch him with others and see him do the same thing. He has a tremendous heart for the game and for others. Winning is not important to Ron. Pitching is and helping others see their potential is one of Ron's strongest gifts.

President Kurt Whaley called the meeting to order.

The September 2, 2011, officers' meeting minutes were reviewed. It was moved by Clint Bryson, seconded by Butch Finton to approve. Motion carried.

The 2012 Preliminary Treasurer's Report was reviewed. No action needed at this time.

Committee Reports:

Trophy: Monte's Woodshop made 10 more trophies at a cost of \$416.00. We had 9 on hand so may not need any more made for 2013.

Clothing: On our SDHPA website there is a link for Brown & Saenger. Just print out the order form and mail with money to Brown & Saenger and they will process the order.

Hall of Fame: Everything is ready to go for the banquet presentation. It was suggested that in the spring mailing people are informed what is needed to nominate someone for Hall of Fame, where to send the nomination, and have a deadline for that nomination being May 31<sup>st</sup>. It will be recommended at the business meeting to donate \$50 to the SD Hall of Fame in Chamberlain, SD.

Kyle Stover Memorial: The CD for this is at Bank West in Pierre and is currently \$2,302.19. President Whaley will speak to Kimberly Stover about what she would like done with the CD.

Website: Connie Filley will present on the SDHPA website at the business meeting.

Vacancy of Officers: The 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President position will be voted on this year. Bryce Chambers currently has the position and has expressed that he would like to have it for another term. No one else has expressed interest in the position. The 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President, State Statistician, and President positions will be up for election in 2013.

Old Business: At the annual business meeting in 2011 it was discussed that we would vote on whether to allow the state tournament to be another weekend besides Labor Day weekend at the 2012 annual business meeting. If this is passed, the SDHPA constitution will need to be changed as well – Article V, Section 3.

New Business:

- Discussed Article IV, Section 7 which states "State tournament is to alternate east and west river each year, subject to the approval of the state officers." Discussion followed on whether to address a change. Several options were discussed and it was decided to bring it up at the annual business meeting to the members to get their input.
- Butch Finton reported on the World Tournament that was held in Knoxville, TN. SDHPA had 4 pitchers participate – Butch Finton, Tom Dunham, Vine Marks, and Lewis Carpenter. Lewis Carpenter placed 3<sup>rd</sup>! Congratulations Lew! In 2013 the World Tournament will be held in St. George, Utah and in 2014 in Buffalo, NY.
- At the World Tournament business meeting, it was passed to change the age of junior cadet pitchers starting in 2013. The age changed from 9 years old to 12 years old so long as they remain 12 years of age for the entire calendar year.
- Pierre has the bid for the state tournament in 2013.
- We will need to vote for 2014 site. Spearfish has put in a bid and Pierre has a standing invitation.
- Volunteers are needed for the weekend. Clint Bryson will weigh shoes. Someone is needed to collect score sheets on Saturday. Will be using electronic scoring on Sunday.

It was moved by Tom Dunham, seconded by Clint Bryson to adjourn. Motion carried.

President Whaley asked for a moment of silence for all of our horseshoe family that have passed away this past year.

The 2011 business meeting minutes were presented. It was moved by Roland Kleinschmidt, seconded by Donnley Elsen to approve. Motion carried.

The 2012 Preliminary Treasurer's Report was presented. It was moved by Bryce Chambers, seconded by Butch Finton to approve. Motion carried.

**Committee Reports:**

A Hall of Fame form will be sent in the spring mailing to inform how to nominate someone for this honor, what information is needed, where to send the form, and the deadline to get this nomination in.

Kyle Stover Memorial: The CD is currently worth \$2,302.19. President Whaley will speak with Kimberly Stover about what she would like done with the CD.

Election of Officers: The 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President position currently held by Bryce Chambers is to be voted on this year. Bryce expressed interest in another term. No one else had expressed interested so he is re-elected for another 3 year term. The 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President (currently held by Butch Finton), State Statistician (Gene Ewing), and President (Kurt Whaley) will be up in 2013. Butch Finton and Gene Ewing expressed interest in holding their positions again.

Old Business:

Last year at the business meeting, members were informed that we would be voting by ballot in 2012 on a proposed change to our constitution – Article V, Section 3. Old wording "STATE TOURNAMENT TO BE HELD ON LABOR DAY WEEKEND. (1988)" New wording "STATE TOURNAMENT TO BE HELD AT END OF SUMMER PITCHING SEASON. EXACT WEEKEND WILL BE CHOSEN BY HOST CLUB AND PUBLISHED WITH SPRING SCHEDULE." Results of the ballot vote were:  
Change to allow flexible date (new wording) – 26



Leave unchanged (old wording) – 7

The Constitution will be changed to the new wording. Pierre has the 2013 state tournament and the club already decided to have the state tournament the last weekend in August 2013 on a trial basis.

New Business:

Discussed Article IV, Section 7, which states “STATE TOURNAMENT IS TO ALTERNATE EAST AND WEST RIVER EACH YEAR, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE STATE OFFICERS. (1988)” After much discussion it was decided that it needed to be changed and in 2013 we would vote for one of two ways to change it:

1. Remove it completely and have the state tournament awarded by bidding and voting, or
2. Have state tournament alternate between 3 regions – East-Central-West with right to use a location with a standing bid

Discussion was held to give a \$50 donation to the S.D. Hall of Fame in Chamberlain as they do not charge us anything for our plaque being displayed there and they run solely off of donations. No one spoke against this so a \$50 donation will be sent to them. Members are also encouraged to give to the S.D. Hall of Fame.

Also on the Ballot was voting for the State Tournament site in 2014. Since Pierre is East River and they are the host site for 2013, it was recommended to the voters to have Spearfish (West River) host in 2014. Results of the ballot vote: Spearfish – 20 and Pierre – 10. The 2014 state tournament will be held in Spearfish.

The 2012 World Tournament was held in Knoxville, TN. We had 4 members from SD participate – Tom Dunham, Lewis Carpenter, Butch Finton, and Vine Marks. Lewis Carpenter placed 3<sup>rd</sup>. Congratulations Lew! Vine Marks was on a YouTube video. In 2013 the World Tournament will be held in St. George, UT and in 2014 in Buffalo, NY. At the World Tournament it was passed to change the age of junior cadet pitchers starting in 2013. The age changed from 9 years old to 12 years old so long as they remain 12 years of age for the entire calendar year. Also Elder pitchers can move back to 40 foot if they choose the next year.

20 Years – Henry Pater, LaVerne Wipf, and Gene Ewing
